

GAMP is a career development and networking program designed for Gonzaga University students and alumni. It works by matching students and graduates with a mentor in a career field related to their academic major or career field. The primary objective is to establish a relationship between the mentee and mentor that facilitates better career-decision-making and the development of a network that results in better job opportunities. GAMP is a very effective career resource and has been instrumental in helping several hundred students and alumni.

Getting Started

Step 1: After completing this registration form come by the GAMP office (room 213) in Crosby Student Center to pick up a copy of the Mentee Handbook and register for a GAMP orientation session. Prepare a mock letter to send to your mentor and bring it along to the orientation session.

Step 2: After attending the orientation session you will be assigned a mentor within 5-7 business days. When you receive your match, contact your mentor **immediately**. The orientation and mock letter are program requirements. Alumni or students currently outside the Spokane area can call for a phone consultation. The purpose of this meeting is to explain program procedures and the basics of networking.

Step 3: **Mentors will not be assigned until after you have attended the Orientation Session and turned in your mock letter to the GAMP office in person, by mail, or via gamp@gonzaga.edu.**

Step 4: Enjoy your relationship with your mentor. Complete the GAMP evaluation and stay in touch. Please update the GAMP office if you discover any changes in mentor information.

***It is important to note that if you want to be considered for future matches all steps in the processes must be completed which includes the evaluation form.**

Responsibilities

GAMP can be an excellent resource for achieving your professional goals, but it does carry some responsibilities. The mentors are busy people who have volunteered their time to help you. If the program is to continue to grow, you must do your part. Once you have received your assigned mentors, it is critical that you contact them immediately. Please be courteous and professional in all your interactions with your mentor. You are an ambassador for Gonzaga University and your actions can have a positive or negative impact upon the entire program.

If you are unable to contact your mentor for any reason, please contact the GAMP office in the Crosby Student Center. If GAMP proves to be helpful to you, we hope you will volunteer to be a mentor in the future.
